Take the Bluegrass Pkwy and exit at #68. For those coming from the west (Elizabethtown) go left. For those coming out of Lexington or east, take a right. Go to the first light and take a left. Go to the next light (McCowan's Ferry) and take a left. Go for several miles (you will go past the historic Jouett House on the right) until you come to Lillard's Ferry and take a right on Lillard's Ferry. Go about ¼ mile and look for a black wrought iron sign with two deer and a turkey (Curry Place View) and turn left. Follow the gravel road until it splits, keep to the left.

Waiver, Assumption of Risk and Agreement to Hold Harmless

I understand that attendance at livestock/stockdog training facility or event is not without risk to myself and guests who may attend, or my dog, because some of the dogs and/or livestock to which I will be exposed may be difficult to control and the inherent unpredictability of livestock and may be the cause of injury even when handled with the greatest amount of care.

In consideration of my participation in the Fair Wether Farm Trial, I hereby waive and release Fair Wether Friends LLC (herein known as Fair Wether), its Partners, handlers, members, agents, livestock owners and any property owners from any and all liability of any nature, and further agree to indemnify and hold harmless Fair Wether and any property owners, handlers and agents from any and all claims including claims by any third party, for injury or damage resulting from the action of any dog or livestock, and I expressly assume the risk of any such damage or injury while attending this trial or other activity at Fair Wether Farm. Dog owners are responsible for any and all costs to any sheep injured during the trial. Sheep are valued at \$200.00 each. By signing this entry, I agree that I have read and understand the statements above.
