

Stockdog 101

Stockdog 101 is a one day clinic for those new to herding, as well as those who are more experienced and would like to brush up on the basics. This clinic is designed to build a solid foundation for the handler and their dog. We will be covering the basic concepts of working livestock - - reading livestock, the working relationship with your dog, pressure & release, flight zones, flanks, balance, outruns, and driving. The day will start with a lecture time with handouts and visual aids. Later in the morning, students will work in pairs on the livestock to learn "hands on" about working livestock without their dogs. Dogs will work twice during the day, with a lunch break in between working sessions.
