Stockdog Manners and Groundwork Clinic is a one of a kind stockdog clinic that focuses on a basic groundwork of exercises that can be done off of livestock. We will be working on basic manners that every stockdog should know, games and exercises that will apply later in herding, as well as an in depth discussion on presence, pressure, and the working relationship with your dog. This clinic is open to all experience levels of herding and all ages of dogs, especially young and un-experienced dogs! The day will start with a lecture time with handouts and demonstrations. After lunch, students will work with their dogs on various exercises and games. **Please note, we will not be working livestock during this clinic - only ground work!
