Random drawing will choose the order of entries arriving on the same day. Run order will be determined by random drawing before the trial and bitches in season will compete last. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the chairman will be responsible or obliged to furnish any services for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be completed due to riots, civil disturbance, Acts of God, public emergencies, or other events beyond the control of the Kentucky Australian Shepherd Club. Owners of dogs will be responsible for all injuries to livestock. At stockowners option, dog's owner will pay for veterinarian services, or if necessary replacement cost. Replacements costs will be Ducks- \$25.00, Sheep- \$200.00, Cattle - \$ Market Value unless contestants are notified otherwise at trial time. Owner/handlers are responsible for their dog(s). Dogs must be crated or on lead at all times, except when competing. The Show Chairman, their agents, officers, and /or committee shall assume no responsibility for injury to children. Judges maybe substituted. No electrical and/or mechanical training devices will be permitted on the show grounds. The Show Rules of the Australian Shepherd Club of America will judge these events. For the safety of your dogs and others, all dogs must have current vaccinations against rabies, distemper/parvo; you are asked to bring a copy of the rabies certificate with you. all dogs must be leashed or crated when not competing!!!

### DIRECTIONS TO SLATE CREEK FARM • 280 MERRIMAC-PECK ROAD

**From Lebanon:** Follow thru Lebanon this turns into US 55/68 at the 2<sup>nd</sup> stoplight after you go thru town (there's a Wendy's on one corner and a BP Gas Station on the other corner) turn Left toward industrial park go to the stop sign. Turn Right, this is 49 follow this to 337 (Tallow Creek Rd.) turn Right approx 7 miles to Barney School Rd./Merrimac Rd. (this is the only crossroad on 337). Turn Left follow this about 2.5 miles and turn Right at first road after you cross a cement bridge, go about 500 ft stay to your left at the fork this is Merrimac-Peck Rd. Go approx. ½ mile cross small bridge look to the left you'll see 2 barns and the pastures by the road on the left with a white house sitting back by the woods.

Or

**From Campbellsville:** Take Hwy 70 out of Campbellsville 10 miles to Hwy 337 (Bradfordsville Rd) turn left and follow it 4 miles. Turn Right follow this about 2.5 miles and turn Right at first road after you cross a cement bridge, go about 500 ft stay to your left at the fork this is Merrimac-Peck Rd. Go approx. ½ mile cross small bridge look to the left you'll see 2 barns and the pastures by the road on the left with a white house sitting back by the woods.

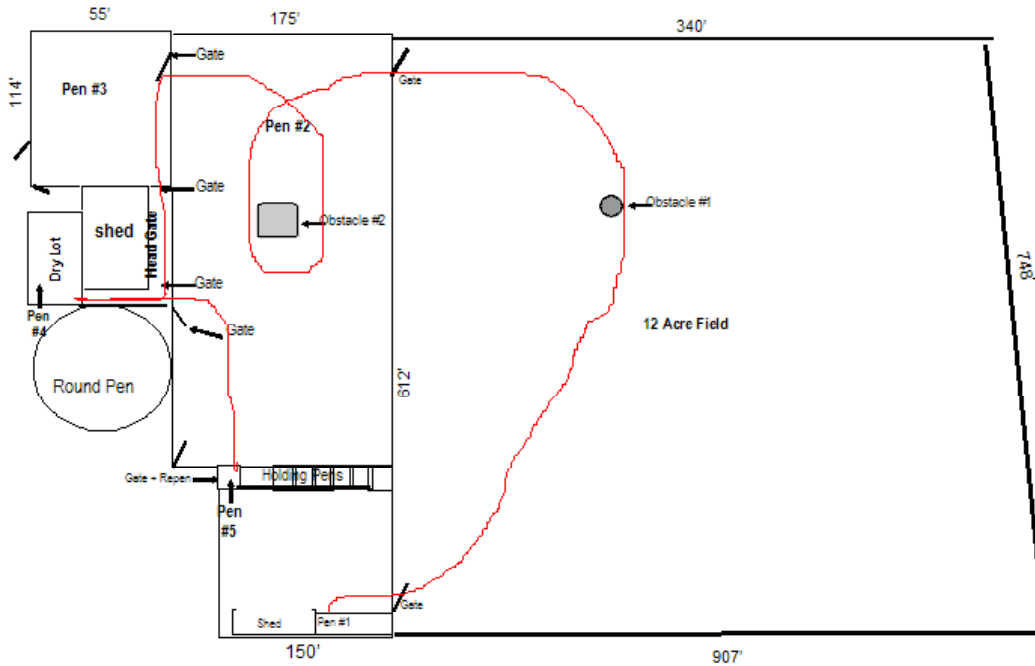

## KASC RANCH DIAGRAM



### RANCH TRIAL DESCRIPTION – Time 20 Minutes

**Step 1** – Gather the stock (10) from Pen #1 – Drive or Fetch Stock thru gate into 12 acre pasture up and around obstacle #1 and thru the gate into Pen #2.

**Step 2** – Drive and/or Gather stock around center obstacle #2 and up toward the road thru gate into Pen #3.

**Step 3** – Move Stock in Pen #3 thru gate behind barn and into squeeze head gate, sort 3 marked stock into Dry Lot Pen #4 and move the rest of the stock into Large Arena Pen #2.

**Step 4** – Drive and/or Gather the 7 stock that are in Pen #2 into to Pen #5 which is the Reopen.

**Step 5** – Return to Dry Lot Pen #4 and pickup the 3 marked stock and move them to Pen #5 Reopen. All 10 are now joined together. **Finished**
